

The Florida campus is located at Catarroja (7Km on the South of Valencia).

There is a free coach service from/to the Catarroja station and the Picanya metro station before and after the morning and evening lectures. + info





#### 2.1. APPLICATION

- Non UE students:

  - VISA or Residence permit in a EU country covering your stay in Spain
  - Insurance covering your stay

Before you arrive you will be asked to send the O.L.A. (Online Learning Agreement)

If you have an exchange mate assigned you will be contacted by him/her before your arrival. He/she can answer your questions about practical daily live in Valencia and Florida.

#### 3.3. SCHEDULES

At your degree web page in Florida website

- 1. Scroll down to "Calendarios y horarios" (=Calendars and schedules).
- 2. Then you need to chose the semester:
  - Primer semester= Fall semester
  - Segundo semestre = Spring semester
- 3. The group (check the group of your selected module in the list of modules)
- In "A.D.E." (Business degree ) The groups "A" and "B" are the morning groups and the the groups "G" are the the evening groups (the modules codes ending with "g" belong to the evening groups")




- 1. Checking the list of available modules I see it is in the group 3º (morning group)

# 4. DURING YOUR STAY AT FLORIDA

#### 4.1. MODULE CHANGES

You can change your module selection during the first month of each semester.

The IRO will provide you with the changes form that you may bring /send it to the registration office ("secretaría", building C, ground floor). You will have to edit your OLA/ LA accordingly.

If you have a problem with a module, please make the teacher aware as soon as possible. For further academic issues please contact the International academic advisor in your degree.

#### 4.2. **ATTENDANCE**

As general rule the courses are face to face and the student have to attend the lectures. At the module guide you may find the minimum percentage of attendance required. You will find communication with teachers in Florida is usually fluent and direct. Please inform the teacher if you are not going to be able to attend or provide a medical certificate if you had medical issues preventing you from attend.

#### 4.3. **EXAMS**

Unlike some European universities, you do not need to sign up to take an exam: once you are enrolled in a module, you are expected to attend the exam.

You have a second chance (re-sit exams) if you fail or not attend the first final exam at the end of the semester.

If you have modules from different groups, please check on the web (at "Calendario de exámenes" = "exam calendar") your exam dates and times, and make sure they don't clash. If they do clash, please inform your teachers at least three weeks in advance.

Erasmus students have the same rights and obligations as local students, with two exceptions:

- Spelling mistakes in Spanish are not penalized in the same way for Erasmus students as for local students.
- Fall semester re-sit exams are done by April. If you are staying only for the fall semester and need to do a re-sit exam, contact the teacher as soon as possible, in case a sooner date can be arranged.


#### 4.5.1. YOUR FLORIDA I.T. CREDENTIALS


At the beginning of your stay you will receive your ID and password for your Florida Account. This includes:


- A Microsoft 365 account

- Florida wifi

#### 4.5.2. FLORIDA OBERTA

Florida Oberta is the internal platform for your modules at Florida. At the Florida intranet <a href="https://www.floridaoberta.com/">https://www.floridaoberta.com/</a> you will find the information about the modules in which you are registered: schedules, communication with teachers, etc.









#### 4.5.3. PRINTING

It the hall of building C you will find this machine (on the right) where you can get a rechargeable card for your printings.

- -The basic cost is one euro and this includes one euro credit.
- -Notice you need to insert the exact amount you want to charge the card with. It does not give change back.

#### Printers:

- You will find one next to the card machine (at building C's hall). At this one you need to insert a memory stick with your files
- At the top floor of the building D, opposite to the library desk, there is another printer that you can use with your card. There you can use computers where you can open your files and select your printing options.
